

2010 UMR-ACUHO Research Grant

Sponsored by the UMR-ACUHO Assessment & Information Management Committee

Purpose

- Provide support funding for research in areas pertinent to residential life and housing.

The Award

- \$500.00 available to support one or more research projects.
- Research may be a 1 or 2 year time line.

Eligibility

- Bachelors degree completed.
- Work at a UMR-ACUHO Member Institution or hold Associate Membership.
- Approval of institution's Chief Housing Officer or Graduate Advisor.

Application Process

- Completed applications and proposals accepted until **October 1, 2010**.
- Research grant(s) announced and awarded at the UMR-ACUHO Fall 2010 Conference.

Grant Recipient Responsibilities

- Submit a summary report approved by the Chief Housing Officer or Graduate Advisor by April 15th, outlining grant progress to date.
- Submit a conference program proposal form by May 1st, designed to share research findings. If the recipient is unable to attend the UMR-ACUHO Fall Conference, information may be presented by the Assessment and Information Management (AIM) Committee.
- Submit a full report with detailed summary of research findings by October 1st, to be incorporated into the UMR-ACUHO Annotated Bibliography.
- Create a poster display of research results for the UMR-ACUHO Fall Conference.
- Write and submit an article for publication in the UMR-ACUHO Winter Newsletter, due by December 1st.
- UMR-ACUHO reserves the right to distribute a summary of the results upon request.
